



Winona Beach Resort North

Rules & Regulations

The Beach has no lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk. Children must be accompanied by an adult. No swimming allowed after 10 p.m., or dusk (whichever comes first). If you save a space on the beach and it is not occupied after a few hours, your belongings will be moved so someone else can use the space. Toys & furniture must be removed at the end of each day, no overnight spot holding. Picnic tables and Adirondack chairs are provided for your convenience. Leave them in their general area and clean up after use.

Bicycles are to be ridden on the roads only and are not allowed in the beach area or on any of the docks. Bicycles must adhere to the 5 mph speed limit. There are absolutely no bicycles allowed in the parking area or near the office. In order to assure that Children stick to the 5 mph speed limit and are safe from traffic, other walkers, dogs, and hazards at other sites, they are not allowed to ride bikes in any part of the park unless they are accompanied by parents walking or riding next to them.

Boat Moorage is available for a fee. Please see the office for the cost of renting boat slips. Boat docks are for boat moorage only. No fishing is allowed on any of the boat docks. Boats must be off the docks by October 1, every year. A fee will apply for boats, left in slips, after October 1st. Winter boat and/or trailer storage can be purchased through the office.

Campfires All wood firepits must have screens/covers. All fires must be attended by an adult. Before starting a fire, please check with the office to see if there are any local fire bans.

Fireworks and Firearms Fireworks are NOT allowed in any form or type at Winona Beach Resort North. All firearms must be locked, and secured in a safe, while on Winona Beach Resort North property. We have a strict no "open or concealed" carry policy on Resort property.

Fishing is limited to our fishing dock or from boats only. Fishing is prohibited from all other docks, the swimming area, or any of the shore areas. A fish cleaning station has been provided. Please clean up after yourself. Fish entrails go back in the lake, do not dispose of them in the dumpsters or trash bins.

The **Gates** are key code operated and should always remain closed. Do not allow other vehicles to come through the gate without entering a code and never give out access codes. Doing so could result in your membership or rental agreement being revoked.

Golf Carts, ATVs, etc. must adhere to the 5 mph speed limit and can only be driven by guests with a valid driver's license. Children are not allowed to drive golf carts or any motorized vehicles on any part of Winona Beach Resort North property. Riders in golf carts, ATVs, trucks, etc. must sit in seats and may not ride on the back of any vehicle.

Pets (limit 2) We are unable to allow the following dog breeds or mixes: Rottweiler, Pitbull, Wolf, German Shepherds and Doberman. All pets must be on a leash or kenneled and never left unattended outside your RV. Excessive barking or whimpering is not allowed. Pets can swim in the areas between docks but are not allowed on the beach in front of the store/office. Proof of pet vaccination is required.

Quiet Time is between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. Be respectful of your neighbors, always observe quiet time and keep music & noise to moderate levels. Please keep in mind that all RVs have thin walls and your neighbors' RVs are close.

Recycling Stevens County does not offer recycling programs, so we are unable to recycle. Please take your recycling home with you.

Restrooms Please clean up after yourself. Our restrooms are serviced regularly. Please notify the office if additional cleaning or servicing is needed.

Respect Your Neighbors We are a small park and noise carries. Your music is for your enjoyment, not your neighbors. Even though it is legal, marijuana smells can be offensive to others so please be aware and respectful. Respect RV site and cabin boundaries and do not cut through other sites. Do not let children run or play through other RV sites and cabin areas.

RV Site Limitations Each Site is allowed up to 8 registered guests this includes the tenant(s)/owner(s). These 8 registered guests will have access to Winona Beach Resort North without additional fees. Families who have more than six children, under the age of 18, may be granted an exception, with prior approval. Designated family or friends must be identified as part of your 8 registered guests at the beginning of each season and cannot be changed until the next calendar year. Additional registered guests can be added for a fee of \$100 per person, per season.

Seasonal RV Site Responsibility Your site needs to be kept clean, orderly, debris and garbage free. You must perform two deep cleanings per season on your site. In the spring your RV must be pressure washed or soap scrubbed and rinsed by May 15th. At the end of the season, toys, tools, hoses, planters, kayaks, floating devices, furniture & tables must be taken home or stored in your RV or a shed. Nothing should be left under or around RVs or on decks. Refrigerators, BBQ's, tables, and chairs may remain outside as long as they are completely covered by tarps and do not trap leaves or pine needles. **Anything left out during fall cleanup will be disposed of and is subject to maintenance and disposal fees.**

Speed, Parking, & Traffic The speed limit at Winona Beach Resort North is 5 mph. Be aware and cautious of kids, pets, and resort maintenance vehicles at all times. Do not park in roadways. Parking spaces are limited so during peak season we may have to limit one vehicle per site. Additional parking is available in the resort's main parking lot or up above the 3rd row. **Do not** block other vehicles and leave room for others to pass on our narrow roads.

Tents One tent per site is allowed under the following conditions: Tents must fit under the awning of your RV, are less than 10ft, are stake-free, and not permanent. A \$25 tent fee per night will be charged and all dates must be approved and coordinated with the office before the stay. The tent fee does not include day use or overnight fees for your visitors.

Trash Please help us keep our park clean! Limit trash to household trash only. Take large broken/worn out items home with you to dispose of (appliances, electronics, BBQ's, fire pits, yard or lounge chairs, cardboard boxes, etc.). We can aid in the disposal of larger items, if coordinated in advance, for a small fee. Dumpsters are centrally located on both levels of the park. Please use trash bags for all garbage and debris to help minimize odor at the dumpsters and debris from flying out.

Visitors - Day Use/Overnight "Visitor" is anyone not on your registered list of up to 8 guests. Visitors are subject to day use and overnight fees and must check in at the office before entering the park. Registered Members and Guests must ensure their visitors understand the Winona Beach Resort North Rules & Regulations. Registered Members are responsible for their registered guests and visitors and held accountable for their registered guests' and visitors' ability to follow the Resort rules.

Wildlife Please do not feed the geese, ducks, turkeys, deer and other animals. We know they are adorable, but it is not good for them to consume human food and become dependent on humans. Our animal friends are also quite messy and they make it hard to keep our resort clean.
